

Show Car Rules & Regulations

- *No loud music
- *No explicit lyrics, graphics, or any other form of explicitness
- *No alcohol
- *No displays with questionable music, videos, art, or other media
- *No Air Horns/revving your engine

Please remember, you are in a public setting so conduct yourself accordingly. DST reserves the right to remove any promotional items within the display area, change booth or charge vendor fees if necessary.

Registration/Entry: If you pre-register online, please bring your Confirmation to be scanned by the judges. You may also pay the day of the event, where you will be given a receipt and directed to the registration table. Registration personnel will assign you a number to be placed on your score sheet to be displayed.

Judging: Judging of the vehicles will start and end according to the event schedule. DST reserves the right to alter or modify the rules to enhance the event. The Judges will have the final say in any conflict that may occur. DST will not be responsible for any unclaimed trophies after the conclusion of the show.

Disqualification/Removal: Any person or Car Club fail to follow the rules and regulations or any verbal instructions from the event staff is subject to disqualification and removal from the event. This also includes unsportsmanlike conduct. DST shall not be held responsible for any damaged or lost property. By registering for the event, said participants agree to adhere to the above car show rules and regulations. No refunds under any circumstances.

End of Show: We recommend that your vehicle and display stay intact until the End of the show. Do not start any vehicles until you have been directed to do so. If you have an emergency and have to leave during the show, please inform a DST Staffer & we can make arrangements for you to pick up the vehicle after the show. If you need to bring in a truck or trailer please have someone line up in the rear of the convention Center our staff will guide you in, we do a hard push out to make room for the trucks & trailers to access the floor.
